Student Attendance



- Students must log in to their class on time for the live instruction
- Participation points will be distributed for attendance
- Failure to log in will result in no participation points for that day as well as being marked absent
- Failure to log in within the first 5 minutes of class will result in a reduced participation point value and/or marked absent

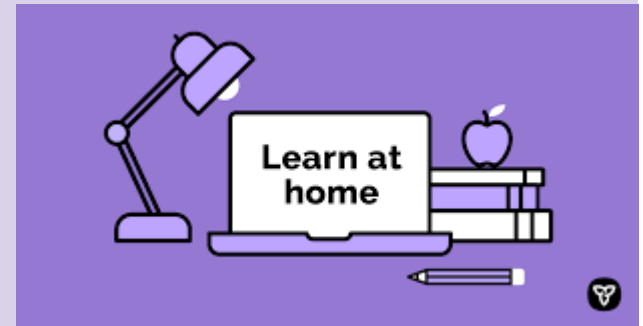

Live Instruction Expectations

- Students should log in for live instructional sessions in a “**ready to learn**” posture and environment to limit distractions. (a designated work space)
- Parents and guests should not be participating in live sessions for confidentiality reasons
- **Common Norms** will be established for live sessions to maintain an appropriate and safe learning environment. Norms that follow the MHS school code of conduct will automatically be included. These will include, but are not limited to:
 - Appropriate attire while video is on
 - Use of inappropriate language (no cussing, swearing or belittling)
 - Student’s screen name **must** be real name

Used to create, distribute, and provide feedback on daily learning activities, assignments, and assessments

GOOGLE MEET - video conferencing tool used for daily live instruction

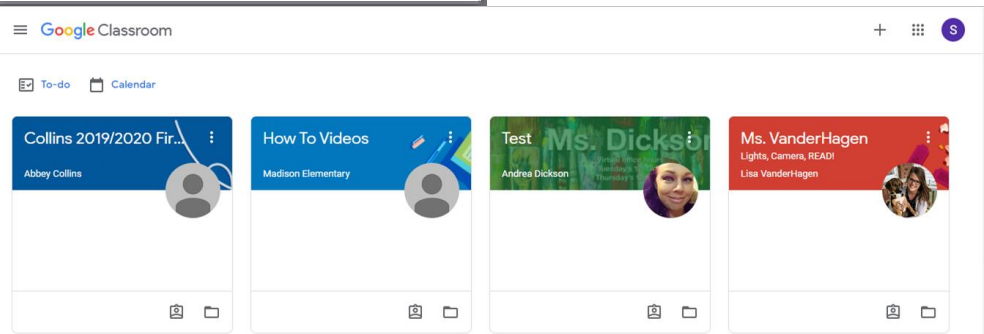
Students will receive their Google Classroom (GC) join code from each teacher.

Sign in ONCE using your school-issued email and then Clever will store your username and password







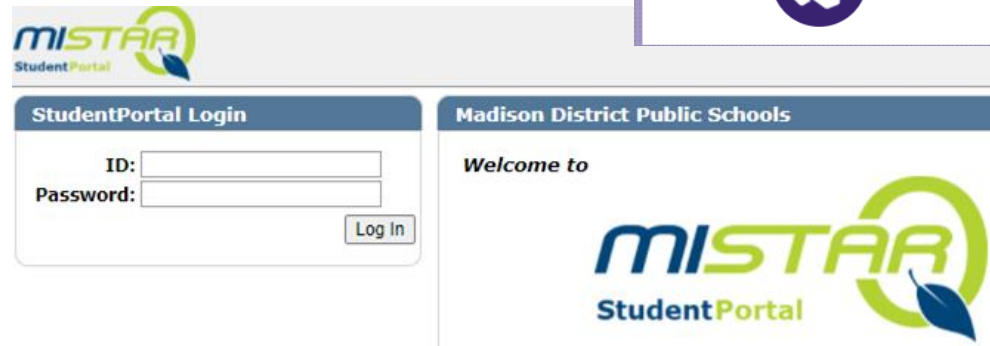
